Vocabulary Activity: gapfill, multiple-choice quiz, guessing (group and pair work)

Focus

Music vocabulary

Aim

To practice vocabulary related to music.

Preparation

Make one copy of the two worksheets for each pair of students.

Level

Intermediate (B1)

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

In this fun music activity, students complete trivia questions about music and then take part in a quiz using the questions.

Procedure

Divide the students into two groups (A and B).

Give each student a corresponding worksheet.

To begin, students complete music trivia questions using the words provided.

When the students have finished, check the answers with each group.

Next, students pair up with someone from the other group.

Tell the students not to show their worksheet to their partner.

Students then take turns reading each music question along with three multiple-choice options to their partner, who has to try to guess the correct answer.

For each correct answer, students score one point.

The correct answers are shown in bold.

The student with the most points at the end of the guiz wins.
